

TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will be organising Transport from the Airport/Train Stations to the Hotels according to the information sent by the teams and according to the ITOs travel arrangements.

Transport from the hotels to the Competition Venue will be through two 50-seater buses available to transport the teams with the following programme:

- The two teams playing at O9.00 leave with bus 1 at 7.50
- The two teams playing at O9.15 leave with bus 2 at 8.00
- The two teams playing at O9.30 leave with bus 1 at 8.10 (in this way the teams arrive at the sports hall one hour before the start of the match)

The same system will be used for the teams playing at the other times of the day.

As regards transport for training, the 13 teams staying at the Hotel Villaggio Hemingway will not need transport as the training courts are adjacent to the village. For the other nine teams, there will be another 50-seater coach and two 8-seater vans equipped for persons with a disability.

Meals will be provided for the teams and the ITOs at the separate hotels. More information regarding the meals at each of the hotels will be given at a later stage.

MEDICAL ISSUES

Each NF is responsible to ensure the appropriate health condition of each individual delegation member according with his or her role. The participating delegations must ensure the coverage by International Medical insurance for the tournament. The Organiser will provide first assistance on site in case of accident and a quick and safe transportation to the Hospital. Each NF is responsible for the cost of any medical assistance in hospital, treatment, diagnosis means, pharmacy, hospitalization, surgery, etc.

Should it be required for all the the European Championships participants to wear masks due to Covid, each team will be responsible to ensure that each team member is supplied with and use their masks according to the regulations issued by the host nation Health Authorities.

ANTI - DOPING

The Anti-Doping Control/Processes will be carried out in full accordance with the WADA Anti-Doping Code.





SPECIFIC COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- The competition shall be played according to the 2022-2024 World ParaVolley Sitting Volleyball Rules and Diagrams and the Specific Competition Regulations for the 2023 European Championships Div. A. All necessary interpretations will be made before the competition during the Technical Meeting.
- 2. The medical classification of the 6 players on the court must be as follows:
 - o A minimum of 5 VS1 classified players on court at all times.
 - o A maximum of 1 VS2 classified player on court at all times.
 - o The above must be adhered to even when the Libero is on court.
- 3. Each delegation will be composed of a maximum of 20 (twenty) members as follows: 14 players, 5 officials and 1 head of delegation. Up to 2 (two) extra officials, and 1 (one) journalist, may be added to the delegation of a team on the condition that their expenses have been paid before the tournament. Any other change in the players list can only be made after application to the Technical Delegate.
- 4. Pool Ranking after Pool stage will be decided as follows:
 - a. Matches Won
 - b. Points
 - c. Set Quotient
 - d. Points Quotient
 - e. Matches between the teams.
- 5. The First placed team in the Men's and W's Tournaments will qualify for the 2024 Paralympic Games. The last three placed teams at the end of the competition will be demoted to take part in the European Championships Div. B in 2024.
- 6. The Molten V5M5000 Flistatec will be the only ball at this competition.

COMPLAINTS AND SANCTIONS

- All complaints and protests must be presented in writing in English to the PVE Technical Delegate no later than 1 hour after the end of the match.
- A deposit of € 250.00 must accompany complaints about the result of a match or protest.





TEAMS ACCREDITATION

The LOC will provide Accreditation Cards to all those taking part in the European Championship Div. A in Caorle.

VISAS

Teams are responsible for obtaining and bearing any costs associated with the necessary visas.

LAUNDRY

At the end of each round of matches, there will be three people who will collect the playing shirts and shorts from the six teams which would have played in that round. The playing shirts and shorts collected in the two rounds of competitions in the morning will be delivered within the day, while the items used in the matches in the afternoon will be delivered the following day.

RESULTS SYSTEM & DISTRIBUTION

All bulletins and other information will be ONLY distributed in electronic format.

During the Preliminary Inquiries, the Team Managers will be asked to give to PVE/LOC a valid email address of an English-speaking representative present in Caorle.

DAMAGES

Each NF is responsible to ensure the appropriate behaviour of each individual delegation member.

Damages at the hotels, training venue, competition venue, or any other venue used in relation to the 2023 European Championships would need to be paid for by the relevant NF.





UNFORESEEN ITEMS

As regards specific items not expressly foreseen in the present regulations, reference is to be made to the general rules and guidelines contained in PVE Regulations.
